***What are the requirements to become an active member of CTWS?***

1. Submit the completed membership application to the CTWS Treasurer.
2. Pay annual dues of \$35.00 for CTWS's fiscal year, October 1 – September 30. (Dues collected from new members from June 1 – September 30, or up to 120 days preceding the end of the current fiscal year may be applied to the member's dues for the following fiscal year.)
3. Attend one monthly meeting/program for free (normally a \$10 fee) and receive a free lunch.
4. After completing the above requirements, the Membership Chairman will send a Welcome Letter stating you are an *active* member of CTWS.
5. You will also receive a directory/yearbook which has all the information concerning CTWS for the year: calendar of events, names of board members and committee chairmen, member addresses, by-laws, exhibit guidelines, standing policies, and general information. Become familiar with the information in the yearbook to help guide you through the year.
6. As an *active* member of CTWS you will be able to take part in all membership activities, such as: Having full voting privileges, attending monthly meetings/programs, submitting a painting for Painting of the Month, participating in winning monthly prizes, attending Multi-day Workshops, submitting 1 to 3 paintings for each of the two McLennan Community College Exhibits and the two Carleen Bright Arboretum Exhibits held annually, and volunteering to serve on committees, as an Officer, and on the Board of Directors.
